Friday, April 17. It wasn’t much of a game. The Hoosick Falls / Tamarac Wildcats dominated the first half from the opening kickoff until the half came to an end. Payton Nealon scored on a one yard dive to start the scoring on the first possession, then Bryan Mackey stepped in front of a pass for an interception at the C-D four yard line and stepped into the end zone. The final score of the quarter came when quarterback Michael D’Agostino tossed a six yard pass to James Blake.

The second quarter was more of the same. Nealon scampered in from 13 yards out and D’Agostino hit Dylan Baker for a 25 yard strike putting the ‘Cats up 34 to zip at the half.

The ‘Cats came out in the second half using backups and JV players, who played well, holding C-D to one score while Jeremiah Bouchard romped into the end zone

from 52 yards out. Wildcats kicker Andrew Yerdon made all of his extra point attempts, putting six points on the board.


D’Agostino threw ten times with five receptions for 102 yards. Jeremiah Bouchard led the running backs with three runs for 55 yards and a touchdown, Josh Colegrave had two rushes for 55 yards and Peyton Nealon had six carries for 13 yards and two touchdowns. The ‘Cats gained a total of 277 yards to C-D’s 72. Receiver Austin Fitzpatrick had two catches for 56 yards, Dylan Baker caught two for 42 with one touchdown, and James Blake caught one for six yards and a touchdown.

The game was the conclusion of the regular season of COVID-19 created Fall Sports II. The ‘Cats went 5-0 in dominating fashion, outscoring opponents 190-17. There will be a two game postseason. The first of those will be against Mechanicville on Friday night. The game is scheduled to be played at Hoosick Falls Central School at 7:30 pm.
