This includes funds to pick up children in the approved Child Safety Zone

PROPOSITION #2: BUS PROPOSITION Shall the following resolution be adopted, to-wit: RESOLVED, that the Hoosick Falls Central School District is hereby authorized to purchase school buses at a maximum estimated cost of \$312,000 and that such amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of said District and col-lected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law; and, in anticipation of such tax, obligations of said District shall be issued.
