Columbia County COVID-19 Update

50% of the County Now Vaccinated

As of Monday, May 3, the Columbia County Department of Health had administered 9,884 first doses of the COVID-19 vaccine. Second doses now number 7,274. The vaccine administered is Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson & Johnson. Note: J&J – a one dose vaccine – is added as a first shot.

The total number of Columbia County residents by all vaccine providers, as shown on the NYS COVID-19 vaccine tracker website: 23,140 have completed the vaccine series. 29,930 have received at least one dose, or 50.0 percent of the county's 59,916 population.

Daily Infection Rate "Constant"

As of midday Tuesday, the Columbia County Department of Health had recorded nine new positive cases of COVID-19. There were two new cases on Saturday and 14 cases combined between Sunday and Monday. County DOH Director Jack Mabb said the infection rate in the county remains "very constant."

One death attributed to COVID-19 on Monday brings the number to 94 of virus deaths in the county since the pandemic's beginning. There are currently no county residents hospitalized as a result of the virus.

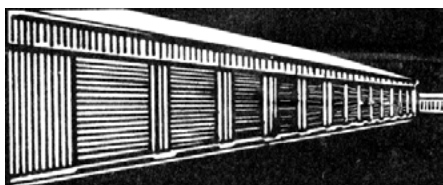

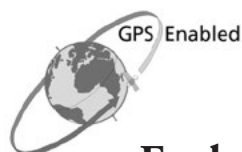

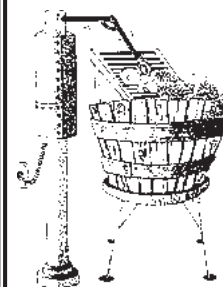
