According to New York State Police, the crash on Route 7 in Pittstown has claimed the life of a village resident, and resulted in other injuries as well. Below is the press release from the State Police.

At approximately 3:48 pm on Friday, May 28, the New York State Police in Brunswick responded to a three-car motor vehicle accident in the area of 2369 State Route 7 in Pittstown just west of the Tomhannock Reservoir.

Preliminary investigation has determined that a Ryder box truck, operated by 22-year-old Anthony J. Wisdom of Paterson, NJ, was traveling westbound on State Route 7 when it crossed the centerline. The

truck collided head-on with an eastbound 2005 Mercury Mountaineer operated by 28-year-old Dylan DelToro of Hoosick Falls. A third vehicle, operated by 43-year-old Jacqueline Bowman of Johnsonville, was traveling eastbound behind DelToro in a 2004 Dodge Ram pickup and was unable to stop, subsequently colliding with the Ryder truck.

DelToro was med-flighted to Albany Medical Center in serious condition and died as a result of his injuries.

Wisdom and his passenger, 27-yearold Rushdi M. Sari of Haledon, NJ, were transported by ambulance to Albany Medical Center with non-life-threatening injuries. Bowman was uninjured.

A check back with troopers shows that at press time the crash remains under investigation.
